FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS SHEET

What are my voting rights in the Association?

- You have the right to vote on amendments, elections and any other item which requires the vote of the membership as long as you are the owner of record.

What restrictions exist on my right to use my unit?

- Guests are limited to once a year during your absence for a period of 21 days excluding immediate family.

What restrictions exist on the leasing of my unit?

- The unit cannot be leased for one year after the date of purchase after which time may only be leased once a year for a period of no less than 190 days and no more than one year.

How much are my assessments to the condominium association for my type and when are they due?
